



Irrigation Permit Checklist & Information

Checklist:

- City of St. Cloud Irrigation Permit Application
- A scaled irrigation plan shall be provided to illustrate compliance with applicable regulations, Irrigation plans shall indicate at a minimum:
 - Location of sprinkler heads, valves, controller and backflow preventer
 - Keep in mind that there shall be a minimum of 4” between irrigation heads, nozzles or emitters on any paved surface, and 12” from walls and building foundations.

Information:

- All required landscaping shall be provided, at minimum, with provisions for a temporary irrigation system sufficient for the establishment and ongoing health of all required landscaping plant material.
- The water source for any irrigation system shall be as follows:
 - Where available, reclaimed water, harvested rainwater, storm water or other alternative water supplies as requested by the Water Authority shall be used for landscape irrigation, and design and installation shall be consistent with applicable regulations.
 - Irrigation wells within the city shall only be permitted if approved through the Water Management District or FDEP through rule or CUP (Consumptive Use Permit).
 - Where no other lesser quality water source options are available, potable water source may be used.
